Criteria for Selecting Enumerators for Polling Station Review Survey

PAFFREL is conducting a survey targeting 1,500 polling stations in 10 districts—**Kandy, Kegalle, Matale, Colombo, Gampaha, Galle, Matara, Ratnapura, Nuwara Eliya, and Kilinochchi** aimed at improving the Accessibility and Neutrality of the polling stations to Improve integrity, Transparency and accuracy of electoral process.

Qualifications for Applicants

1. Applicants must be between 25 and 40 years old.
2. A minimum educational qualification of GCE Advanced Level or higher is required.
3. Applicants must reside in the relevant district.
4. A good understanding of the geographical area of their district is essential.
5. The ability to maintain strong interpersonal relationships with Grama Niladhari officers, government officials, and community leaders is required.
6. Applicants should possess technical knowledge and have a good understanding of internet use.
7. Applicants must have no direct affiliation with political parties and should work independently.
8. Attendance at all training sessions and district-level meetings organized by PAFFREL in relation to this survey is mandatory.
9. Good communication skills and the ability to work well with PAFFREL Coordinators are required.
10. Since the survey needs to be completed within a specific timeframe, applicants must commit to full-time availability for this work for at least one month, with no other external commitments.
11. Owning a motorcycle is an additional advantage.
